Get Reading

Read a selection of story books with vour child.

Which is your favourite book? What happens in the story? Can you act it out?

Challenge: Can you write your own story?



Get Scientific

Why not go on an autumnal walk? You could talk about what changes as the seasons move from summer to autumn. You could collect some leaves, conkers or acorns and bring them into school. Do you know the names of any trees or plants?



Get Speaking

In the EYFS it's really important that children can express their needs and wishes to their key person. Talk to your child about how they are feeling and role play ideas of what to say if they need help.



Get Active

Can you complete at least three sessions of exercise a week? How many star jumps can you do? How far can you run?



Get Creative

Can you find leaves or other natural objects and make a picture or pattern using these?



Get Cooking

As the weather gets cooler, soup is a great meal to eat to keep you full and warm. Can you cook some soup using different ingredients such as a variety of vegetables? Can you write out the ingredients?



Get Mathematical

How many ways can you make 10 or 20? Can you use objects or numbers to show this?
