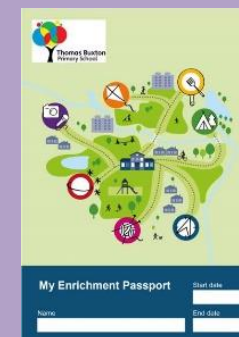
Get Creative
