Get Reading

Can you think of a different ending for the story?

Get Outside

Or you can build a cosy den inside, you could put sheets over two chairs and snuggle down with a good book!

- Design your den, make a list of what you will need.
- How could you make your den even better?
- Can you make a den to fit ALL of your family in?

Get Creative

Have you got any old socks lying around?



Make a sock puppet using an old sock or an old pair of tights. If you have a needle and cotton you can carefully sew on button eyes and material ears. Or you can glue circles on for eyes.

Get Speaking

As we will be reading a lot of books about food and shopping this half term it would be great if you could keep exploring different recipes!
